My name is Jennifer, and I'm a volunteer at a Victorian non-profit organisation called Happy Brain Education, and I am excited to announce that we are looking for volunteer mentors for our mentoring program! 😊

Our vision as an organisation is to level the playing for Victorian youth everywhere. One of the free services we provide is our mentoring program, which aims to empower students from a refugee background and to support their learning and growth by pairing them up with a mentor. As a mentor, you'll be assisting the mentee in various different areas such as connection building, career planning, sharing knowledge and experience and assistance with resume-writing.

The time commitment for a volunteer mentor is a minimum of 8 sessions within a time period of 12 months. Sessions are held at a public place agreed on by both the mentor and mentees, and can be scheduled at a time convenient for both. Being a mentor is a largely flexible commitment, as well as being a highly rewarding experience, as you are playing the part of a positive role model and guide in the life of a young student!
